Founded to address the need for immediate access telephone crisis services, our goal is to provide round-the-clock access for people in need. Through services that emphasize confidential, non-judgmental, and compassionate listening, CONTACT's trained volunteers alleviate despair, isolation, distress, and suicidal feelings in callers from East Tennessee and beyond. There are no fees for our services and we largely depend on individual donors for funding.





We're excited that overall funding was up in CY 2017. This increase allowed program expansions. Some funding is related to grants that will be expended in 2018.


Individual, Foundations, and Corporate giving totaled \$52,291




Program expenses totaled \$62,352. Almost 93% of the dollars donated to Contact go to meet the needs of people in our area.
